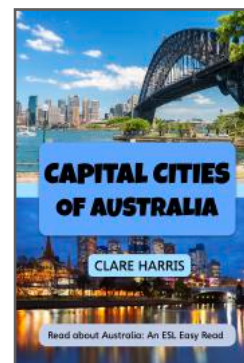


READ ABOUT AUSTRALIA:

Matching activity



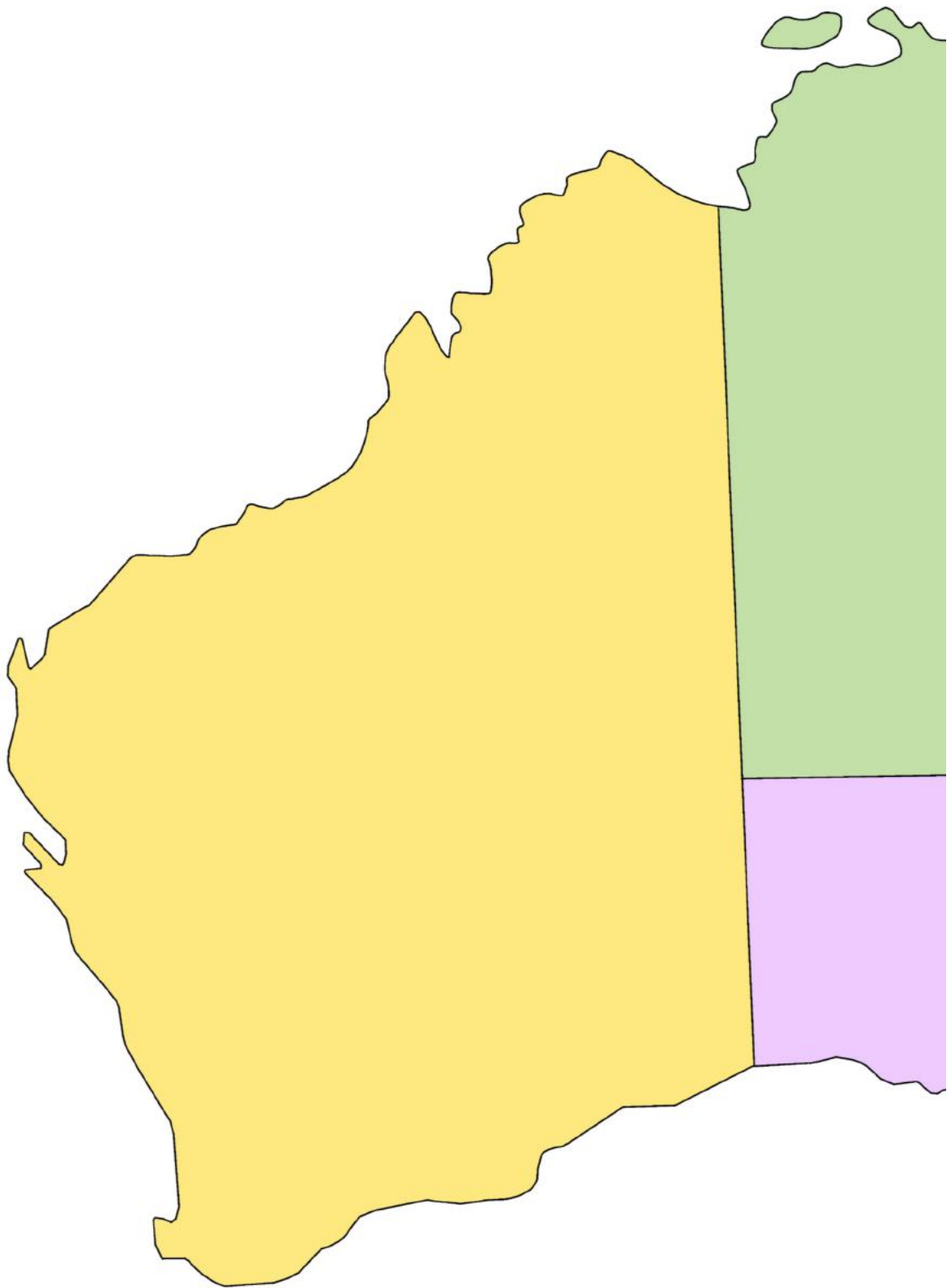
This is a post-reading activity, especially useful for learners who are still gaining confidence around names and locations.

You could project a large outline map onto a screen, draw an outline, or print the next two pages onto A3 (or even better, A2). Learners add the state or territory, capital city and photograph (cut out, laminated, with some way to attach to board). You can mark the capital city locations, or use the red dots to for extra challenge.

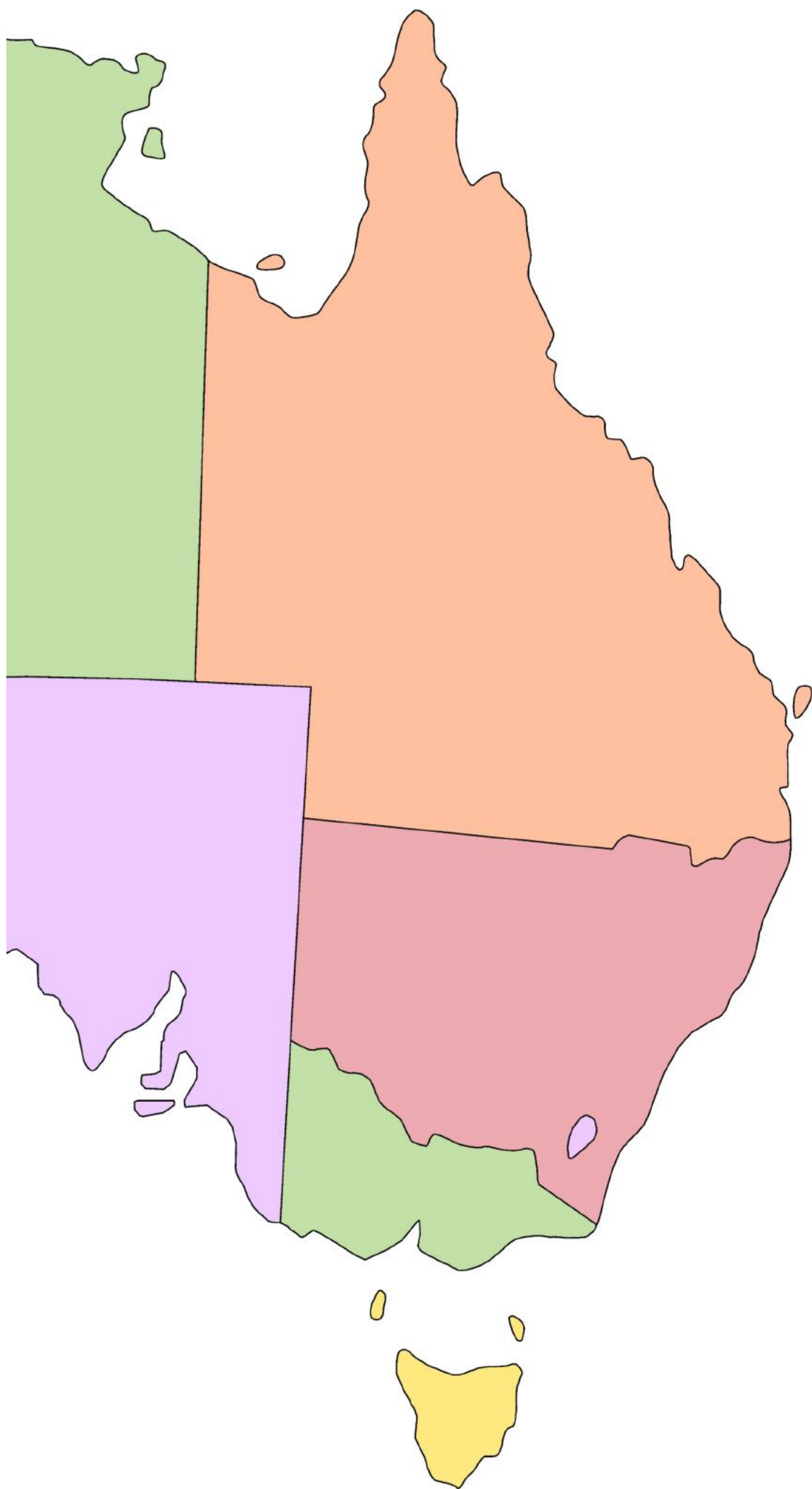
